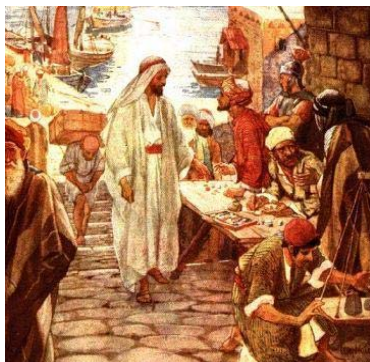


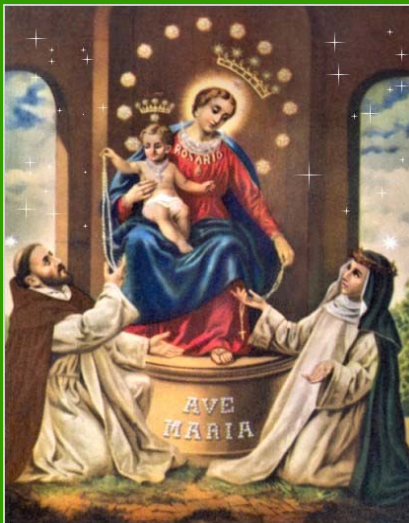
## Holy Rosary Church

**“Yes, Father”**



Both John and Jesus had their greatest success in their mission not with the religious leaders, but with such marginal figures as tax collectors and sinners. These marginal persons listened

to the teaching of John and Jesus and they became disciples. Like the first son in the parable, these people, they were slow to believe at first, but then they became faithful followers. Like the second son in the parable, the Scribes and Pharisees were listening to but did not accept the message. God’s kingdom of grace is available to every person; there is hope for everyone because God is kind and merciful. But words are not enough: Jesus said clearly, “Not those who say, “Lord, Lord” will enter the kingdom of God, but those who do the will of my Father”.
