33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dan 12:1-3; Heb 10:11-18; Mark 13:24-32

“Your kingdom come”

The 2009 liturgical year is coming to an end and on the last two Sundays the readings lead us to reflect on “eschatology”, the end time, the fulfillment of the Kingdom of God. The prophet Daniel describes the “great tribulation,” the resurrection of the dead and the divine judgment with rewards and punishments. This scenario includes the earliest description of the resurrection of the dead in the Old Testament. The letter to the Hebrews contrasts the animal sacrifices offered by Jewish high priests, “which can never take away sin” with the one perfect sacrifice of Jesus which obtained forgiveness and reconciliation with God. This new relationship with God represents the inauguration and anticipation of the future coming of God’s kingdom in its fullness. Jesus urges us to be always vigilant with hope and confidence that God is surely bringing to a glorious completion his kingdom in us. And so with Jesus we continue to pray, “Your kingdom come”.
