Your love to my world about me.

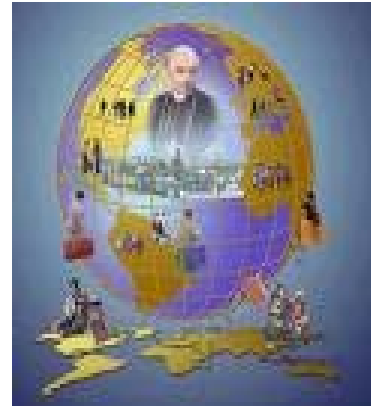

**Scalabrini Missionaries
Anniversary**

November 28 is the anniversary of the founding of Scalabrini Religious Community. Bishop Scalabrini while visiting the 360 parishes of his diocese realized that over 28.000 of his people had migrated to North America and to Brazil and they were begging him to send them an Italian priest. On November 28, 1887 the Pope approved the new Order of the Missionaries of St. Charles, known as Scalabrinians. Holy Rosary was one of the first parishes to receive an Italian priest in 1890. Today the Scalabrini Missionaries serve migrants and refugees in 32 countries. Please, join us and thank God for bishop Scalabrini, a prophet and a saint, and pray for all the Scalabrini Missionaries and for the millions of migrants and refugees.

I am very grateful to the families who contributed a donation toward the work done at the rectory. The cost was \$15,800. So far \$2100 donation was received. Thank you.



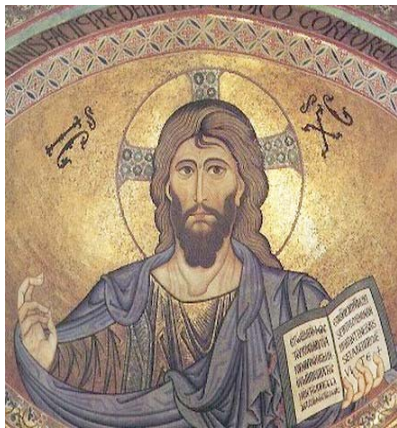
**Thanksgiving

LỄ CHÚA KITÔ VUA

Dan. 7:13-14; Rev. 1:5-8; John 18:33-37



Hôm nay là Chúa Nhật cuối của năm lịch giáo hội. Trong suốt 52 Chúa Nhật vừa qua, chúng ta đã vinh danh cuộc đời và sứ mệnh của Chúa Giêsu và chúng ta đã thấy tình thương yêu và ơn lành mà Thiên Chúa ban cho chúng ta. Chúa Giêsu bảo Philatô trong phúc âm

rằng nước Người không thuộc về thế giới này. Người là vị lãnh đạo Chân lý được Thiên Chúa gửi đến cho dân Người. Lúc Người lên trời, Chúa Giêsu nhận được “quyền năng, vinh dự và vương quốc” vĩnh cửu muôn đời. Chúa Giêsu tiếp tục dẫn dắt dân Người với tình yêu thương vô bờ bến và chúng ta làm lại lời cam kết trung thành với Chúa Giêsu, là Chúa và là Vua của chúng ta.

Kỷ niệm hội truyền giáo Scalabrini: Ngày 28 tháng 11, 1887 Đức Giáo Hoàng đã chính thức chấp thuận dòng tu mới của các nhà truyền giáo thánh Charles, được gọi là những người hội Salabrini, nhằm phục vụ chăm nom giáo xứ và xã hội cho những di dân gốc Ý ở Nam Mỹ và Ba Tư. Giáo xứ Holy Rosary là một trong những giáo xứ đầu tiên nhận được linh mục người Ý vào năm 1890. Ngày nay hội truyền giáo Scalabrini đã phục vụ cho các di dân và người tị nạn trên khắp 32 nước trên thế giới. Xin hãy hiệp ý để cảm tạ Thiên Chúa đã ban cho chúng ta giám mục Scalabrini, một nhà tiên tri, và là bậc thánh và cầu nguyện cho tất cả các nhà truyền giáo Scalabrini.
