**3rd Sunday of Easter**

*Readings: Acts 5:27-41; Rev 5:11-14; John 21:1-19*

**“It is the Lord”**

“Easter faith” is the conviction that Jesus has been raised from death and has become the Lord of life. “Easter Faith” develops gradually as we see in the gospel story. Some disciples are fishing in the Sea of Galilee. Fishermen often worked at night to be able to sell fresh fish at the market early in the morning. This particular morning the disciples have an early buyer; a stranger appears on the shore and asks them if they have any fish. They answer him that they had a bad night and caught nothing. He invites them to try

again and lower the net on the right side of the boat. To their surprise this time the net comes up full of fish. John recognizes the stranger as Jesus and tells the others, “It is the Lord”. They are not quite sure, yet. Jesus asks for some fish and prepares a BBQ fish breakfast for them. By now they are pretty sure that it is Jesus. Jesus continues to make surprising visits in our life also; we need to be attentive to recognize him.



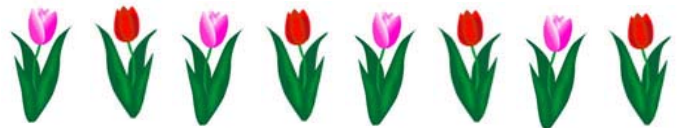
### **The disciples' tough mission**

Today's story in the Acts of the Apostles report that the apostles are in jail because they worked miracles in the name of Jesus. They are liberated miraculously at night and they are out preaching again about the risen Jesus. The high priest questions them, “We

gave you strict orders not to mention Jesus any longer ... and you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and want to bring this man's blood upon us”. Peter courageously answers, “We must obey God rather than any human authority”. The “Easter faith” makes a difference in the lives of the first disciples and in ours. A personal with the risen Jesus transforms people's lives.

Khi họ đem cá đến cho người khách lạ, thì ông Gioan nhận ra đó là Chúa Giêsu. Chúa Giêsu cầm lấy cá và nướng để làm bữa điểm tâm cho họ. Trong khi các môn đệ ăn uống thì vài người trong họ vẫn còn hoài nghi về Người, nhưng cuối cùng thì họ nhận ra là Chúa Giêsu phục sinh. Chúa Giêsu đã hiện ra trong sự ngạc nhiên của các môn đệ, và chúng ta nữa hãy tỉnh thức để nhận biết Người.
