Sixth Sunday of Easter

Acts 15:22-29; Rev 21:10-23; John 14:23-29

The age of the Spirit

Jesus prepares his disciples for his return to the Father. The coming Holy Spirit will lead them to the full understand of Jesus' teaching and guide them in the development of the new community as we seen in today's reading. A momentous decision in the early community was made. The question was: "Do the gentile converts need to be circumcised and observe the Jewish laws in order to become Christians? The apostles gathered in Jerusalem with Paul and Barnabas openly debated the matter and after much prayer and hot discussions this conclusion was reached: "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and ours not to impose any new burdens on the new converts..." The decision meant that the new community was no longer a part of Judaism, but it was on the way to become a world religion. This gathering of the apostles in Jerusalem is considered the first Council in the Church and a turning point in Christian and Jewish history.

In our time the Spirit guided the Church through the Vatican Council II and among the many achievements a dialogue began with other religious denominations and with political government leaders. The guidance of the Spirit is needed today in our complex religious and political world. Personally we need to discern the presence of the Spirit who guides each one of us in our day to day living.

Report from Haiti

Fr. Sergio Morotti, cs, rector of the Scalabrini Seminary in Haiti wrote an article in a magazine informing people how the donations received were used to help thousands of people affected by the earthquake. Our seminary and missions edifices were build in the 1980's following earthquake proof regulation and received only minor damage. Part of our seminary and two retreat centers were occupied by over 100 people, religious, 50 Red Cross workers, journalists and politicians who volunteer to help the earthquake survivors. Our seminary and mission are able to offer free room and board to all volunteers. The mission clinic is busy 24 hours a day and in the soccer field two emergency hospitals were set up. Fr. Sergio thanks all the generous donors of Holy Rosary parish and assures us of the prayers of hundreds of grateful people who benefited from our generous help.

CHÚA NHẬT THỨ VI PHỤC SINH

“Tuổi Chúa Thánh Thần”

Chúa Giêsu chuẩn bị mọi việc cho các môn đệ của Người trước khi Người về cùng Chúa Cha. Chúa Thánh Thần trong những ngày sắp tới sẽ giúp họ hiểu tường tận về những lời giảng dạy của Chúa Giêsu và hướng dẫn họ để thành lập một cộng đồng mới. Chúng ta sẽ thấy điều này trong bài đọc hôm nay: Chúa Thánh



Thần dẫn dắt các môn đệ chấp nhận những người ngoại đạo mà trước đây những người này đã bị loại khỏi danh sách “dân được chọn”. Đây là một quyết định khó khăn chỉ có được sau khi cầu nguyện và bàn cãi nhiều lần: “Thật là tốt cho Chúa Thánh Thần và chúng ta khi tất cả các quốc gia được sáp nhập vào đại gia đình Thiên Chúa”. Đây là một khúc rẽ mới trong lịch sử Do Thái và Thiên Chúa giáo.

Trong thời đại chúng ta, Chúa Thánh Thần đã hướng dẫn Giáo Hội qua Công Đồng Vatican Thứ II cũng như đạt được bao nhiêu thành quả đối thoại với các cộng đồng tôn giáo khác và các nhà lãnh đạo quốc gia. Chúa Thánh Thần rất cần cho chúng ta trong lúc này, trong một thế giới đa tôn giáo và chính trị. Mỗi cá nhân trong chúng ta phải nhận ra sự hiện diện và soi sáng của Chúa Thánh Thần trong đời sống hàng ngày.
