Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11; Ephes. 1:17-23; Luke 24:46-53

“He ascended into Heaven”

When the disciples had come together, Jesus said to them, “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem... and to the ends of the earth.” Then as they were watching, Jesus was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. Suddenly two men in white robes stood by them and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come back in the same way...”

Jesus’ Mission is complete, now it is our mission to continue his work of building the kingdom of God. (Acts 1:8-11)

The celebration is Sunday May 23: special mass at 11 am Mass followed by a short procession outside the church. After the prayer a shower of rose petals come down over Mary’s statue and the devotees collect them and take them home believing that they secure Mary’s blessings and good health for another year. A first time visitor took a handful of rose petals last year and claims that he experienced a miracle the same day. He was called by the doctor for a heart transplant.

Feast of Pentecost

We reflected in last Sunday’s reading from the Acts of the Apostles how the first big crisis in the early church was solved: “It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and ours (Apostles) to open up the New Christian Community to the gentiles”. It was a turning point in the history of the Jewish and Christian Communities. In the Vatican Council II (1962-65) it was the Spirit again to inspire the Council members to write, “The Catholic Church deeply appreciates what other Christian churches and ecclesial communities have contributed and are contributing cooperatively to the realization to make the human family and its history more human. Similarly the Church is convinced that there is a great variety of help that it can receive from the world in preparing the ground for the Gospel, both from individuals and from society as a whole, by their talents and activity.” (Document: Church & Modern world). The Spirit unites, politics separates.

The Church and the world still need the guidance of the Holy Spirit: human wisdom and politics are not sufficient. Let us pray for a new infusion of the Spirit.

55th Anniversary

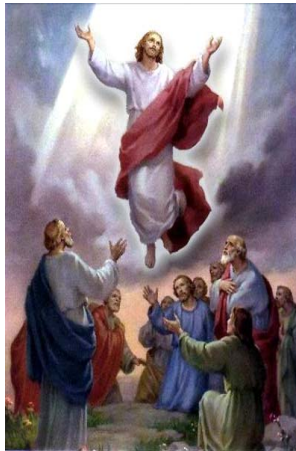
