“Yes, Father”

Jesus has great success in his mission with marginal people like tax collectors and sinners; they listen to his teaching and become his disciples. Like the first son in the parable today, they were slow to believe but then they become faithful followers. Jesus did not have much success with the religious leaders: like the second son in the parable they listen to Jesus' teaching just to find fault and to contest it but do not accept it. Jesus tells them that the kingdom of God is available to every person; there is room for everyone. People are saved not by words but by deeds. “Not those who say, “Lord, Lord” will enter the kingdom of God, but those who do the will of my Father”. Are we good listeners and good followers of Jesus' message?

The service will begin at 10:30 am with a procession around the block and at 11 AM a special Mass in church. Chúa Giêsu đã thành công trong sứ mệnh của Người với những người thu thuế và những kẻ tội lỗi; họ lắng nghe lời Chúa và trở nên môn đệ của Người.
